On 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, the Eco Club and Swachhata Action Plan (SAP) Committee of Chellammal Women's College organized a Swachhata Hi Seva Pledge Ceremony to commemorate Mahatma Gandhi's vision of a clean and developed India, as part of the Swachh Bharat Mission. A total of **200 students** enthusiastically participated in the ceremony.

Mr. Thangaraj B.T., District Coordinator for Chennai, National Green Corps, administered the pledge to the students. The event encouraged participants to reaffirm their commitment to cleanliness and hygiene as both a personal and national duty. The pledge called for dedicating 100 hours per year, i.e., two hours each week for voluntary cleanliness activities. Participants pledged neither to litter nor to allow others to do so, taking responsibility for their surroundings. They also vowed to begin the cleanliness drive with themselves, their families, and their workplaces, promoting a culture of shared responsibility within their communities.

The ceremony highlighted that nations stay clean when citizens act responsibly and discourage littering. Participants pledged to motivate at least 100 others to take the same pledge. The event concluded by reaffirming the institution's commitment to environmental responsibility and Mahatma Gandhi's vision of a clean India.
