At the organic farm, we observed natural farming methods that avoid chemicals and protect the environment. The nursery visit helped us understand how different plants are grown and cared. Finally, the solid waste management unit showed us how waste is sorted, recycled, and reused. In the evening the volunteers organized a cultural programme. The day started with zumba exercises at morning 5am. We had an hour energetic exercise. The students NSS Secretary M/S. Divya conducted the zumba class for the volunteers and they learned the importance of exercise for the daily life. We

had tea at 6a. m. Then the volunteers cooking team-I, cleaning team-II and washroom cleaning team- III involved in their works. Morning 7 to 8a.m they were getting ready for the programme and had their breakfast. We had a session regarding the legal awareness programme. The Advocates S. Vinoth BA BL., and G. Srinivasan B.E., MBA., LL.B., (Criminal and Civil side) presided over the program and elaborated on the importance of legal awareness for the students and self-help group of the Vellaputhur Village. Advocate S. Vinoth explained the maintenance act section 18, section 25 and prohibition of child marriage act 2006 section 9- 12 and POCSO act. Advocate G. Srinivasan explained the Cyper crime offences like IPC section 66D, 67 and online defamation section 500 and criminal intimation section 503.volunteers posted many questions about property law. afternoon 12 to 1p.m the village cleaning started with the cleaning of kallukanvilai street. After the lunch again we started the palm tree plantation at 2 to 3p.m. We have planted 5000 palm seeds near the pond in Vellaputhur. As part of the NSS special camp we conducted a family wise Literacy survey at 3 to 4p.m at Vellaputhur Village. A total of 50 families were surveyed of which 46 families were found to possess digital knowledge and 4 families identified as having limited digital awareness. The NSS units confirmed that most of the villagers regularly use smart phones, the internet, YouTube, Google, UPI transactions, E-Sevai DBT and other government services. Awareness about OTP and password security was also

found to be satisfactory. Our NSS volunteers visited each household and explained smartphone usage and UPI safety. This survey demonstrates that the impact of the Digital India initiatives as having been well established in the lives of the villagers. Through the NSS special camp volunteers gained practical community experiences. We visited the organic farm 4.30 to 6.30 p.m. M/S. Bhaghiyalakshmi explained the solid waste management, decomposed and composed waste. She elaborated on the maintenance of accounts, seeds preservation and maintenance of mother bed. At 7.30 students were getting ready for the cultural and our students M/S. Divya and M/S. Dhanalakshmi danced and performed a skit. We had a reflection hour and the students gave the feedback of the programme and activities.

NSS slogan "Not me but You" the true spirit will reflect in their life.

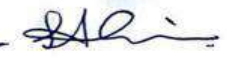
